DEVELOPING A SENSITIVITY TO GOD Psalm 32:1-11

INTRODUCTION: Our Lord desires for us to develop our sensitivity to Him so that we may detect His delicate guidance He desires for us to walk in. Sadly, so many miss God's direction for their lives because they think many of the things the Lord allows in their lives to train them are actually against them: Romans 8:28-29. Don't miss that little word "all" in verse 28! James 1:2-4; Hebrews 5:11-14.

I. OUR LORD'S TEACHING AND DIRECTING!

Our Lord does not want to lead us like a mule must be led. Psalm 32:8-9. Our Lord wants our hearts so desirous of His leading that we will keep our eyes on His eyes. We don't want to be like the children of Israel whom God called stiff necked: 2 Chronicles 30:1-12. Sadly, today many even in the Church of God laugh when called to repent. Our Lord wants us to have a sensitivity to His guidance so that we are directed by His slightest leadings. We must learn to keep our eyes on our Lord at all times: Hebrews 12:1-2; Romans 12:1-2. Our Lord desires to live His life through our bodies if we will yield ourselves to Him. Galatians 2:20-21.

II. DEVELOPING A HEARING EAR!

In order to be able to develop a seeing eye we must first develop a hearing ear. John 10:24-29. Our Lord desires to give each of His children a hearing ear: Proverbs 20:12. Many are not willing to submit to the Lord but are you willing to be made willing to submit to Him? Philippians 2:13: If you are willing to made willing to hear and see the Lord, He will open your ears and your eyes: 2 Kings 6:15-17. We need to be able to hear and see with the eyes of faith!

III. WE NEED A GUIDED TONGUE!

Our Lord, after we get a hearing ear and a seeing eye will give us a guided tongue: Isaiah 50:4-11. Our Lord Jesus said He spoke only what the Father told Him to say: John 8:28-32. We in the same way are told to speak and serve Christ by God's leading, not our own leading: 1 Peter 4:10-11. Each of us were saved to do very specific works for Christ's glory that our God has prepared for us to do. Ephesians 2:8-10. Our Lord desires all of you, not just what you want to give Him at your set time. James 3:1-8. You and I cannot tame our tongue but if we will keep our eyes on the Lord and our ears open to the Lord we will be speaking His Words for His glory!
